

Castle is a keeper

A LOST castle has been identified as one of medieval England's most important strongholds.

Sheffield Castle deserves a place in English history alongside the likes of the Tower of London, archaeologists say.

The site is in the centre of the city but the structure was destroyed after the Civil War.

The little still remaining was unearthed during recent redevelopment.

University of Sheffield archaeologists said: "The castle was an important political and cultural centre and home to aristocrats who played major roles internationally."
